Re: Qualifying Dates and Competitions for the 2026 USEF Dressage National Championships for the Intermediaire division.

This preliminary information is being provided to assist you with your competition planning and may be subject to change. Please remember that this information is based upon the recommendations of the USEF Dressage Sport Committee and the final qualifying requirements are subject to approval by the USEF Board of Directors or the USEF Executive Committee.

<u>Date and Location</u>: The 2026 U.S. Dressage Festival of Champions is scheduled to take place on August 24-30, 2026, at HITS Lamplight Equestrian Center in Wayne, IL.

<u>Qualifying Period</u>: The qualifying period for the 2026 USEF Dressage National Championships ("Championships") for the Intermediaire I division will begin on July 22, 2025, and end on July 27, 2026.

For this Championship, qualification is athlete/horse combination based. Therefore, any change to the athlete during the qualifying period will result in a new combination for qualifying purposes.

<u>Age Requirements for Athlete and Horse</u>: Athletes and horses must meet the FEI qualification criteria in accordance with the current edition of the FEI Dressage Rules found <u>here</u> to earn scores towards the ranking list and to compete in this Championship.

Qualifying Competitions: Qualifying Competitions include national USEF/NAYC Qualifying Competitions as well as U.S. and foreign CDI1\*, CDIO or CDI-Am events. However, a combination cannot earn a score in a national Qualifying Competition if their respective CDI division is also offered at the same event. Qualifying Competitions held over the course of a weekend are considered one qualifying opportunity, even if they have separate license/recognition numbers.

The 2025 FEI Calendar can be found <a href="here">here</a> and please note that the 2026 FEI Calendar will not be published on this link until approved by the FEI, no later than December 31, 2025.

Scores earned from the 2025 U.S. Dressage Festival of Champions cannot be used towards qualifying for the 2026 U.S. Dressage Festival Champions.

Qualifying Tests: Hors de Concours entries are not permitted in national Qualifying Competitions.

Combinations must earn at least three (3) scores in the current edition of the FEI Prix St. Georges Test and at least three (3) scores in the current edition of the FEI Intermediate I Test during the qualifying period



Certificate of Capability: A minimum of one (1) FEI Prix St. Georges Test score or a minimum of one (1) FEI Intermediate I Test score must be earned in a CDI1\*, CDIO, or CDI-AM event and be a minimum score of 67% during the qualifying period.

Additionally, combinations must also earn at least one (1) score in the FEI Intermediate I Freestyle Test. The Freestyle Test score must be earned in an FEI Intermediate I Freestyle Test or an FEI Freestyle Test of Choice class held at a national Qualifying Competition or a CDI during the qualifying period. Freestyle scores will automatically be noted on the final ranking list and are not used in the calculation of a combination's overall average. When more than one Freestyle score is earned at a national Qualifying Competition, the highest score will be noted on the final ranking list.

Tests completed at a national Qualifying Competition must be officiated by a panel of at least two (2) USEF 'S' and/or FEI Judges. Freestyle Tests completed at a national Qualifying Competition must be officiated with a minimum of one (1) USEF 'S' or FEI judge. For CDI Events, <u>FEI Dressage Rules</u> apply.

## **Ranking List Score Calculation:**

- a. USEF will automatically track scores for combinations which are earned at national Qualifying Competitions.
- b. Scratches, eliminations, and withdrawals will not be penalized.
- c. CDI Scores: CDI scores are calculable at the option of the athlete and will only be computed into the combination's overall average upon receipt of a USEF CDI/CPEDI Report Form within the specified deadline stated on the form to the USEF Dressage Department. Scores submitted late will not be accepted. It is the sole responsibility of the athlete to ensure that all qualifying CDI scores for this program are submitted to USEF on time and are accurate.
