#### **Insurance**

USEF does not carry insurance on any horse placed in its custody and is not responsible for any accident, lameness, illness, injury, or death that could happen during stabling, training, transportation, or in connection with the Event. Owner may, of course, and is encouraged to secure their own insurance coverage.

## **Administration of Substances not Required for Emergency Situations**

Lunger is a "Person Responsible" under the FEI Equine Anti-Doping & Controlled Medication Regulations ("Regulations") for any violation of the Regulations, and who is subject to penalty. Therefore, during the Participation Period, no substances will be administered to the Horse unless the USEF appointed veterinarian first obtains written consent from the Lunger, except when an emergency situation has occurred as described below. All USEF appointed veterinarians are subject to the FEI Veterinary and Equine Anti-Doping & Controlled Medication Regulations, and any violations of same may subject the veterinarian(s) to penalty.

## Treatment and/or Administration of Medications for Emergency Situations

In the event of an emergency situation that occurs during the Participation Period, Owner hereby provides their authorization and consent to the USEF appointed veterinarian to treat and administer substances for the medical care of the Horse. A USEF representative must notify Lunger of such treatment as soon as practicable.

#### **Financial & Logistical Information**

All financial and logistical information for the Event will be outlined in the Athlete Memorandum, Instruction, or equivalent, which will be circulated to athletes prior to the Event. USEF assumes no responsibility for salaries or other benefits.

#### Sale of Horse

If the opportunity arises for Owner to sell the Horse during the Participation Period, Owner agrees that the transfer of ownership will not take place until after the expiration of the Participation Period, unless both USEF and the purchaser consent in writing to the transfer of ownership while this Agreement is in effect. Furthermore, Horse will not be shown for sale during the Event.

By signing this Agreement, the undersigned certifies that they are the legal and recorded owner of the Horse and they have the legal authority to bind any and all additional owners of Horse. 1
