Dear U.S. FEI Eventing Athletes:

The FEI has announced the first edition of the FEI Pan American Equestrian Confederation (PAEC) Championship of the Americas. The Eventing portion of the competition will run January 26-28, 2027. The Dressage and Show Jumping phases will be held at the World Equestrian Center (WEC) in Ocala, Florida. The Cross-Country phase will be held at the Florida Horse Park (FHP) in Ocala, Florida.

Championship Information:

The Championship will be:

- Hosted once every quadrennial
- A Team and Individual competition
- All three phases will be held at the CCI2*-S Level

Schedule:

- Horse Inspection: Tuesday, January 26, 2027 - WEC
- Dressage Test: Tuesday, January 26, 2027 - WEC
- Cross-Country: Wednesday, January 27, 2027 - FHP
- Jumping Test: Thursday, January 28, 2027 - WEC

USEF will field a team for the Championship in 2027 if it is aligned with the USEF Eventing Pathway Program vision. More information will be published on the USEF website [HERE](#) as we receive details from PAEC and FEI.
