



Athlete Funding - Jumping

Updated 2025

The USEF Jumping Program supporting the U.S. Jumping Team is a competition-based program. Funding for athletes is dependent on selection to and participation at identified CSIO Nations Cup events, Games and Championships as well as Short Lists for identified Games and World Championships.

Funding is dependent on a number of factors including but limited to:

- Approved annual budget;
- Grants provided, or costs covered, by Organising Committees and/or the FEI;
- Number of invitations the U.S. secures to compete at CSIOs;
- Number of CSIOs and their location that the athlete is selected for; and
- Agreed targets and priorities for the U.S. Jumping Team.

The funding provided for each competition will be confirmed to the athletes through the Selection/Logistics Memo but athletes may contact the Jumping department at lhesson@usef.org to discuss outline funding plans.
