## Were there any other circumstances that affected the day (i.e. lack of help, insufficient material, etc.)

Everything ran smoothly in SJ. The jump crew were professional guys and the rings were maintained excellently throughout the entire three days of show jumping. Water and drag breaks were scheduled during and after divisions. Pro jump crew and arena maintenance crew maintained the footing well for all divisions. Material was adequate, some older jumps with pin cups, some newer jumps with keyhole track. The downside to this is that there were a mix of cups and therefore cup depths.

## Give a brief description of any changes you would make if you had to build the same track again:

I was very happy with the two star track, would have liked to have seen a few more horses jump it. With the one star track, I like the change making it less technical but wish I had put a five stride distance somewhere. I had all 6 and 7 strides in the related lines.

## Are there any other comments that you would like to offer about your courses:

This was the first time for me building in this part of the country. There were a mix of quality of horses and riding. The One star had mainly young riders competing. I was very happy with the results not knowing the quality of riding or horses beforehand. It is however a one and two star and we must build to the specifications. The numbers in the divisions were small so I only got a small sample size to see the courses ridden.
