As announced last week, Tokyo has confirmed the Olympic competition schedule and secured all venues for use next year. This was great information to receive and will serve as the foundation for many decisions as we move forward. Paralympic F&F leads – we will continue to keep you posted as we receive additional information.

## CoSport Update

In accordance with Tokyo 2020's Ticket Policy, ticketholders may proceed in one of two manners:

- 1. In principle, the Games tickets that have been already purchased will be valid on the newly scheduled date.
- Ticket can be cancelled upon your request if you will not be able to attend the session on the newly scheduled date.

CoSport must receive any requests for cancellation by the end of business on **July 31**, **2020**. For those that still plan to attend the Games, their ticket purchases have been aligned with the new competition schedule.

Whenever new information is received, we will use a phone-tree type system, where I will send the information to you and you may relay the information to your family delegation coordinators, and they may share with all of the travelers in their party. In the past, this has been helpful to streamline communication and ensure it is shared with all members of our friends and family delegation.
- 3. We will begin to have monthly friends and family webinars to discuss topics of interest and questions that you might have. The first webinar will be on <u>Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM ET (5:00 PM CT/4:00 MT/3:00 PT)</u>. I will send out a meeting invitation following this email for this call, as well as following months (second Tuesday of the month).
- 4. If you do not yet have access to iGames (Team USA's Games Planning Extranet), please let me know and I can send instructions for you to receive updates.
- 5. Both the USOPC and Tokyo 2020 have resources to help friends and family members find accommodations in Japan. Tokyo 2020 will be publishing their resources in the coming weeks and I will share this information as soon as possible. An outline of their program is located on the <u>Team USA Friends and Family website</u>, including hotel and university dorm options.
