Participation in these classes accrues double points for the USHJA Zone Horse of the Year standings and double points for the USEF National Horse of the Year standings.

Appendix A. USEF Hunter Schooling Rules

- 23. The use of materials that proves dangerous is forbidden, this includes but is not limited to lattices.
- 27. The use of draw reins, chambons, de gogues, or similar tack when schooling over fences must be done in a safe manner. If draw reins, chambons, de gogues, or other similar tack attach to the girth between the legs, they must be run through a yoke or neck strap, and if attached on the side, they must be attached to the saddle or billets.

 unsound will be eliminated and ineligible for an award in that class. The judge's decision

- a. Option A: Trot a circle on a loose rein following any equitation round over fences. Exception: Jogging will not be required in testing phases.

b. Option B: In hand jog preceding a championship/finals class.

HJ130 Completing the Measurement Form

- 1. c. For sections or divisions requiring measurement (Hunter Ponies, Jumper Ponies, Junior Hunters, Welsh Ponies, and Equitation), a microchip must be scanned and identified by the competition steward or official veterinarian prior to measurement. This includes measurements for show purposes only. If multiple microchips are found, or the microchip scanned does not match the one on record with the Federation, this information must be included on the Measurement Form prior to submission. Competition management will be responsible for providing a working microchip scanner.
 - d. The owner, rider, trainer, or coach who has signed the entry blank at the competition must furnish the above information immediately before the pony is measured, this individual is certifying that all information is complete and correct. This individual must be a Federation Senior Active Member. The form must be signed by the measurement official appointed to measure.
