Re: Planned Selection Methods – Pan American Games

Planned Selection Method: Please be advised that it is proposed that selection for 2019 Pan American Games for the Jumping Team be comprised of a combination of the [Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Ranking List](#) (Ranking List) and [Discretionary Selection](#). Click [HERE](#) for the Ranking List.

It is anticipated that Jumping Squad will consist of five (5) athletes: four (4) Team Members and one (1) Traveling Reserve.

A minimum of three athletes and their horse(s) from the five highest ranked athletes on the Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Ranking List, who have applied, will be selected to the Pan American Team based on the recommendation of the USEF Chef d'Equipe to the USEF Jumping Sport Committee and USEF Board of Directors or their designees. The other two athletes and their horse(s) will be selected at the recommendation of the Chef d'Equipe based on Discretionary Selection. It is anticipated that the Ranking List date for selection will be between May 3 and June 17, 2019. The Ranking List date for selection as well as the criteria to be used for Discretionary Selection will be confirmed in the approved Selection Procedures that will be posted on www.usef.org/jumping in December 2018.

Funding: The financial support for the Jumping Team will be confirmed later this year.

Equine Transportation: Currently there is little information regarding the transportation and Pre and Post Quarantine Requirements for Lima. This could impact the selection dates, selection criteria as well as competition plans pre and post Lima. We will share the detail as soon as we have more information.

Human Anti-Doping: Please be reminded that athletes are subject to in-competition drug testing while competing under FEI rules. In addition, athletes in the out-of-competition testing pool are subject to out-of-competition testing. The Prohibited Substance List can be found [HERE](#). It is your responsibility to know if you are taking any medications on the Prohibited Substance List.

Equine Anti-Doping: Please be reminded all horses that are registered with the FEI or USEF shall be subject to in-competition testing. Additionally, the FEI has authority to conduct intelligence based out-of-competition testing (See Equine Anti-Doping Rules, Article 5.1) The FEI Prohibited Substance database can be accessed [HERE](#).

This preliminary information is being provided to assist you with your competition planning. Please remember that this information is based on the recommendations of the USEF Jumping Sport Committee and is subject to approval by the USEF Board of Directors and therefore subject to change.
