**Excerpts from the 2021 Selection Procedures:**

**North American Junior and Young Rider Championships:** Athlete/horse combinations wishing to compete in the 2021 NAYC must have earned two Certificates of Capability as described below, at USEF or FEI licensed competitions between **September 1, 2020 and June 28, 2021**. The two requirements (height and water, where applicable) may be met either in the same or different courses.

1. North American Young Rider Championships:
  - a. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.45m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less.
  - b. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course with either a 3 meter open water jump with or without a rail. In either case, the jump must be in accordance with USEF JP128.
2. North American Junior Championships:
  - a. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.40m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less.
  - b. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course with either a 3 meter open water jump with or without a rail. In either case, the jump must be in accordance with USEF JP128.
3. North American Pre-Junior Championships:
  - a. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.30m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less.
4. North American Children's Championships:
  - a. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.20m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less.

**USEF National Junior Jumper Championships (Prix des States):** Athlete/horse combinations wishing to participate in the 2021 USEF Junior Jumper National Championships (Prix des States) must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.40m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less at USEF or FEI licensed competitions between September 1, 2020 and August 31, 2021.
