

Application Instructions for the USEF Grand Prix Dressage National Championship

The Qualifying Requirements for the 2026 USEF Grand Prix Dressage National Championship are now available here. Applicants for the 2026 U.S. FEI Dressage World Championship Team are not required to submit an application for this Championship. The Application and payment must be submitted electronically.

To access the application of intent:

- 1. Sign into your USEF account at www.usef.org
- 2. In your Member Dashboard, select the blue tile labeled 'Athlete Dashboard'
- 3. Select the blue tile labeled 'Commonly Ridden Horses' you will need to make sure the horse(s) you wish to earn an invitation for Festival are listed here.
- 4. Return to your 'Athlete Dashboard'
- 5. Select the blue tile labeled 'Online Applications'
- 6. Leave the 'Date Range' boxes blank
- 7. In the 'Title' box blank type Grand Prix
- 8. Select the red Search button
- 9. Scroll down the page until you find the application for your respective championship
- 10. Very Important: Leave the 'Submit App For' box blank unless you are submitting the application on behalf of another athlete and NOT signed into his/her USEF Member Dashboard
- 11. Select the 'Apply' button
- 12. Follow the steps from here.

<u>APPLICATION & FEES</u> – Please read the application paragraph in the qualifying requirements very carefully and note that deadlines will be adhered to with <u>no exceptions</u>.

Monday, March 2, 2026	Application Deadline and Fee	\$75 per horse
Monday, March 9, 2026	Late Application Deadline and Fee	\$300 per horse

Horses are permitted to be added to an existing application with a \$75 fee per horse by March 9, 2026.

NO APPLICATIONS, REFUNDS OR CHANGES TO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MARCH 9, 2026 at 11:59pm, ET.

Upon submission of your application, an automatic email will be sent confirming the date your application was received. Therefore, please ensure the email listed on the application is current. If you do not receive an acknowledgment of your application, **IT IS YOUR OBLIGATION** to contact kbrett@usef.org to determine if it has been received.
