Re: Selection Procedure Amendment – Passport Expiration Date

The following amendments will be made to the athlete procedures:

DRESSAGE:

Section 1.A.1. Nationality/Passport Requirements - The athlete must be a national of the United States and in compliance with FEI General Regulations, 23rd Edition, Article 119 (see www.fei.org) at the time of application, selection, and until the conclusion of the 2019 Pan American Games Dressage Competition (“the Event”). Athletes must hold a valid U.S. passport that does not expire until after ~~January 26, 2020~~ **March 3, 2020**.

EVENTING:

Section 1.A.1. Nationality/Passport Requirements: The athlete must be a national of the United States and in compliance with FEI General Regulations, 23rd Edition, Article 119 (see www.fei.org) at the time of application, selection, and until the conclusion of the 2019 Pan American Games Eventing Competition (“the Event”). Athletes must hold a valid U.S. passport that does not expire until after ~~January 26, 2020~~ **March 3, 2020**.

JUMPING:

Section 1.A.1. Nationality/Passport Requirements: The athlete must be a national of the United States and in compliance with the FEI General Regulations, 23rd Edition, Article 119 (see www.inside.fei.org) at the time of application, selection, and through the conclusion of the 2019 Pan American Games Jumping Competition (“the Event”). Athletes must hold a valid U.S. Passport that does not expire until after ~~January 26, 2020~~ **March 3, 2020**.
