



## Application of Intent for the U.S. Dressage Festival of Champions

The Qualifying Requirements for the U.S. Dressage Festival of Champions are now available. Please select [HERE](#) for the Qualifying Requirements, Tentative Schedule, Qualifying Competition Calendar, and CDI Report Form. The Application of Intent and payment must be submitted electronically. To access the application, you will need to log into your [USEF athlete dashboard account](#). Be sure to have your USEF Membership ID and password available. Once you are logged in, you will select the 'Athlete Dashboard' button and then select 'Online Applications.' From there, you will select the red 'Search' button and scroll down the page until you find the application for your respective division.

Very Important: If you have not added the horse(s) on which you plan to apply for on the application to your commonly ridden horses you will need to do so at this time. This can be done from your athlete dashboard under Commonly Ridden Horses. If you do start the application and add commonly ridden horses while the application is open, the commonly ridden horse's page will open in a NEW tab in your internet browser. Once the process for adding a commonly ridden horse is complete, you will need to click the refresh button on your application to see the latest horse added to your profile. From there you will be able to proceed with the application.

**2019 U.S. Dressage Festival of Champions APPLICATION & FEES** – Please read the application paragraph in the Qualifying Requirements (Page 1, Section I) very carefully, and note that deadlines will be adhered to with no exceptions.

Tuesday, June 18, 2019	Late Application Deadline and Fee	\$150

***June 18, 2019 is the last date an application can be accepted.***

Young & Developing Horse Applicants: A copy of your horse's breed registration papers must be submitted by 5:00pm, ET no later than July 29, 2019 in order to receive an invitation to the National Championships.

Upon submission of your application, an automatic email will be sent confirming the date your application was received. Therefore, please ensure the email listed on the application is current. If you do not receive an acknowledgment of your application, **IT IS YOUR OBLIGATION** to contact USEF to determine if it has been received.

Please read everything very carefully, especially the Qualifying Requirements and Application of Intent!
